Stewards Individual Placements provides individuals with service and career opportunities to strengthen communities and preserve our natural resources.

Stewards, in partnership with the National Park Service, are seeking an intern to serve as Community Volunteer Ambassador.

POSITION DETAILS

- Length: position is 50 weeks, 40 hours/week
- Start Date: Monday, February 7th 2022
- Living Allowance: Baseline allowance of \$500/week*
- AmeriCorps Award: \$6,345 (pre-tax)
- Application Due Date: **01/07/2022**, or Until Filled
- Members will attend a week-long, nationwide, National Early Service Training
- Members will receive Public Land Corps Hiring Authority upon completion

ABOUT THE SITE

Tumacacori sits at a cultural crossroads in the Santa Cruz River valley. Here O'odham, Yaqui, and Apache people met and mingled with European Jesuit and Franciscan missionaries, settlers, and soldiers, sometimes in conflict and sometimes in cooperation. Follow the timeworn paths and discover stories that connect us to enduring relationships, vibrant cultures, and traditions of long ago.

POSITION SUMMARY

The CVA will work closely with Tumacacori's interpretation staff, in particular, as well as with the staff of other park divisions. The primary goals of this position are to enhance connections between the park and local communities, and to expand the diversity of the park's volunteer program to better reflect the culture and history of the local area.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Build upon the park's existing contacts to increase and strengthen networks with neighboring Spanish speaking, Mexican and Mexican-descended, O'odham, Pima, Yoeme (Yaqui) partners
- Work to attract a more diverse volunteer pool representative of the culture and history of the local area
- Work with volunteers to represent the park at cultural, historical, and other outreach event opportunities
- Assist the park in planning and carrying out cultural special events
- Utilize a wide variety of means including social media, written materials, displays, in person meetings and presentations, and informal gatherings to accomplish park goals

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Education related to the position, such as history, public speaking, community organization, etc.
- Ability to communicate well, orally and in writing
- Ability to work well in a team environment
- Self-motivated, able to work well without close supervision
- CVA must be friendly, enjoy meeting people and working with volunteers and the public
- Education: High School diploma/GED required
- Between the ages of 18-30 years old (35 years old if you are a veteran)
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Submit proof of a Driver's License and undergo a Federal Background Check, upon selection
- It is very likely that all participants will be required to be fully vaccinated to serve in the 2022 CVA Program. At a minimum participants will be required to get tested weekly if they are not vaccinated. Dates for implementing these requirements are not yet determined, but we expect that compliance will be necessary by the end of 2021.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Spoken and written fluency in a related language – Spanish, O'odham, or Yaqui
- Open to working flexible hours, and some weekends or evenings

HOUSING

Park housing will be available.

*If site is unable to provide housing at no cost, up to \$65/week may be allocated to support rent.
